## HEADQUARTERS, 99TH READINESS DIVISION

Constituted 23 July 1918 in the National Army as Headquarters, 99th Division

Organized in October 1918 a Camp Wheeler, Georgia

Demobilized in November 1918 at Camp Wheeler, Georgia

Reconstituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as Headquarters, 99th Division

Organized in October 1921 at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania

Reorganized and redesignated 12 February 1942 as Division Headquarters, 99th Division

Ordered into active military service 15 November 1942 and reorganized at Camp Van Dorn, Mississippi, as Headquarters, 99th Infantry Division

Inactivated 27 September 1945 at Camp Patrick Henry, Virginia

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 7 November 2007 as Headquarters, 99th Regional Support Command, United States Army Reserve

Activated 17 September 2008 at Fort Dix, New Jersey

Reorganized and redesignated 16 October 2018 as Headquarters, 99th Readiness Division
