Inactivated 15 June 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 11 June 1954 as the 329th Engineer Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 30 June 1954 at Fort Belvoir, Virginia

Inactivated 13 June 1961 in Libya

Activated 8 April 1965 at Fort Lee, Virginia

Inactivated 26 November 1970 in Vietnam

Activated 1 September 1980 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 15 July 1988 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Withdrawn 3 May 2004 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 16 September 2007 at Saint Cloud, Minnesota


