Constituted 19 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 2d Battalion, 82d Engineer Combat Regiment

Activated 25 January 1943 at Camp Swift, Texas

Reorganized and redesignated 29 March 1943 as the 291st Engineer Combat Battalion

Inactivated 20 October 1945 at Camp Patrick Henry, Virginia

Redesignated 6 May 1947 as the 363d Engineer Combat Battalion and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 21 May 1947 at Louisville, Kentucky

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 30 June 1950 at Louisville, Kentucky

Redesignated 2 May 2013 as the 363d Engineer Battalion

Activated 16 September 2015 at Knightdale, North Carolina
