REPUBLIC OF KOREA PRESIDENTIAL UNIT CITATION.—The Republic of Korea Presidential Unit Citation which was awarded by the Republic of Korea to the following unit of the United States Army is confirmed in accordance with AR 220-315:

8238th Army Unit, Advance Detachment, Military Intelligence Service Group Far East	REPUBLIC OF KOREA PRESIDENTIAL UNIT CITATION awarded by citation dated 3 March 1952, by Syngman Rhee, President of the Republic of Korea, for outstanding and heroic performance of duty on the field of battle during the period of 8 July 1950 to 3 March 1952, inclusive, with citation as follows: This unit was one of the first United Nations elements to arrive in Korea, entering on 8 July 1950, immediately after the outbreak of hostilities. It has been highly instrumental in providing the United Nations Forces with extremely essential intelligence data of both a strategic and tactical nature. Composed of highly trained specialists this group has played a vital role in providing intelligence data to United Nations air, sea, and ground forces in all phases of the war. It performed exceptionally meritorious service during the difficult and dangerous operations in the vicinities of Seoul, Inchon, Wonsan, Hamhung, and Hungnam in the trying days of late 1950 and early 1951. Its continuous flow of vital intelligence to user agencies has been highly valuable, and the performance of this group merits the highest praise.
