I—GRENADA CAMPAIGN PARTICIPATION CREDIT. Announcement is made confirming campaign participation credits for operations in Grenada under the provisions of paragraph 9-4, AR 672-5-1. When entering individual credit on Personnel Qualification Record (DA Form 2-1), this general order may be cited as authority for such entries for personnel who were present for duty as a member of or attached to a unit listed at some time during the limiting dates.

1. Combat zone. The island nation of Grenada, including Grenada, Carriacou, Green, Hog, Calivigny, and other outlying islands and adjacent waters.
2. Time limitation. 23 October through 21 November 1983.
