68TH SUPPORT BATTALION

Constituted 1 May 1936 in the Regular Army as 2d Battalion, 45th Quartermaster Regiment

Redesignated 1 April 1942 as 2d Battalion, 45th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Activated 9 May 1942 at the Oakland Sub-Port of Embarkation, California

Battalion broken up 1 December 1943 and its elements reorganized and redesignated as follows:

Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 68th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile

(Companies E, F, G, and H as the 3464th, 3465th, 3466th, and 3467th Quartermaster Truck Companies, respectively—hereafter separate lineages)

Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 68th Quartermaster Battalion, Mobile, inactivated 26 November 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 68th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Redesignated 14 July 1966 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 68th Transportation Battalion

Activated 25 August 1966 at Fort Carson, Colorado

68TH SUPPORT BATTALION

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 17 October 1992 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 68th Support Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 17 October 2006 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 68th Support Battalion

Redesignated 16 February 2022 as the 68th Support Battalion; concurrently Companies A, B, and C constituted and activated
